

## Camps Art & Nature During October holidays 2021

We are proposing to the children two weeks mixing observations and creativity to discover nature and be inspired by it for artistic and creative activities.

The second week will be co-animated by a storyteller who will take the children on a journey through Nordic mythology. Several **immersive outings** in the forest, along the lake and at the educational farm of Bassenges are planned.

They will be combined with many creative, artistic and fun activities inside.

Collaboration is an essential element of the week. The emphasis will be put on living together and cooperation in the activities in general. It will be reinforced by collaborative games.

**The objective of the week: to enjoy and be inspired by nature, to create, to play, to discover, to explore, to have fun, to experiment and to use all one's senses to fully benefit of this week.**

Kids (24 per week) will be grouped to the extent possible into activities that best suit their age group. There will be rest/nap times for the younger children. *Please note that the camp language will be French.*

Drawing, painting, clay, paper constructions


Dance and motion

## Place and schedules

The camps will take place in the Polychinelle building on the ground floor (**GA** building, [map.epfl.ch](http://map.epfl.ch)).

*Parking spaces are available in front of the building.*



To enter the building, ring first **l'écoline bell** on the front door.

You can then enter provided you wear a mask.  
Please also disinfect your hands upon entering.

## Equipment
