# Regulations on competencies regarding proceedings before administrative, civil or criminal courts

of 15 March 2022, status as at 1 January 2025

The Direction of the Ecole polytechnique fédérale de Lausanne,

based on Art. 4, para. 1 of the <u>Ordinance on the Organisation of the Ecole polytechnique</u> <u>fédérale de Lausanne</u> (LEX 1.1.1)

hereby adopts the following:

## Article 1 Goal and Sphere of application

The present regulations are intended to define the competencies regarding administrative, civil and criminal proceedings brought by or against EPFL.

#### Article 2 Competencies

- <sup>1</sup> The competencies regarding administrative, civil or criminal procedures are defined in Annex 1 of the present regulations.
- <sup>2</sup> Where an act shall be subject to prior notification, this is requested by the lawyer drafting the act. This lawyer then submits the act to the competent individuals for determination, accompanied by the notification(s); this determination concerns the conclusions met by EPFL, and where necessary, the principle of instigating legal proceedings or lodging an appeal. Prior notification does not bind the individuals taking the decision.
- <sup>3</sup> Reporting requirements applicable to EPFL in accordance with the <u>Directives du Conseil des EPF concernant la gestion des risques des EPF et des établissements de recherche</u> (LEX 1.4.0.3) and the <u>Directives du Conseil des EPF concernant le devoir d'information des EPF et des établissements de recherche en cas d'incidents particuliers</u> (LEX 1.8.0.2), as well as the provisions in Annex 3 of the <u>Financial Regulations</u> (LEX 5.1.1) regarding disputes for which the value exceeds Fr. 50,000, remain reserved.

#### Article 3 External consultant mandated by EPFL

- <sup>1</sup> The Head of Unit to whom the legal counsel responsible for drafting the act reports may decide to mandate an external consultant in order to assist or represent EPFL with the agreement of the Director of Legal Affairs and, where necessary, the Unit at the origin of the proceedings. The Director of Legal Affairs signs all procurations concerning the court representation of EPFL.
- <sup>2</sup> The fees for external consultants mandated are covered by the Unit at the origin of the proceedings.
