• Actionuni delegate: Victoria Abou Khalil (excused sent a report)

Victoria our delegate participated in a meeting paid for by ActionUNI in Bern to discuss overarching concerns dealing with the CI in all of CH. She also participated in a round table of institutional measures Universities and Federal institutes might implement to help the situation of young researchers

• Catering and DEI committees: Jade Maï Cock (excused sent a report)

The representatives surveyed the PhDs about catering, and so a meeting was requested to Bruno as the intermediate body. Mainly we talked about:

• vegetarian day not having good vegetarian options (taking out the protein is not making it appealing)

- the prices being too high for what is on the plate, and prices are disproportionate (compared to professors whose salary is much higher)
- satellites had a lot of issues with food
- not enough gluten free food, or misindicated gluten free food (potentially dangerous)
- Allergens are not correctly indicated

Now:

- satellites have their own focus group and direct line with Bruno
- PhDs also have a direct line with Bruno
- One gluten free meal in each big restaurant, caterers have been trained on EPFL's dime
- Allergens are now clearly indicated in the campus app For the DEI commission:
- pilot harrassment awareness workshop in IC, to be extended to the other departments
- collaborations have been made between different faculties
 - Events: Immigration workshop and Vivapoly in May
 - Consultations: EPFL Strategic Plan 2025–28, DEI Strategy, Changes to Lex 1.1.1
 - other meetings with admin: catering, HR for "new CI FAQ", AVP-R for postdoc initiatives, Alumni center for postdocs
 - EPDA and PolyDoc Uniting: reorganize to be all under the ACIDE umbrella
 - o Bridging the gap between PhDs, postdocs and staff scientists
 - Ensuring financial support amidst budget cuts
 - Sharing common burdens (admin work, office)
 - ACIDE as the only OFFICIAL representative for EPFL's intermediate body
 - Terminated contracts: General Secretary, Consulting and Event Organization Firm (DEFNA sarl), International Spouses (incl. French courses), web hosting (now under EPFL), and employee insurance
