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Material

Material to be taken all week:

- 1 change of clothing, comfortable and not valuable
- 1 apron or old shirt for painting
- 1 backpack for daily outings
- 1 water bottle
- 1 pair of slippers
- 1 toothbrush
- Sunscreen

- Closed shoes recommended for our forest outings
- For quiet time, you can bring books, a small cushion, a blanket or a comforter

ACCIDENTS/INCIDENTS
