

How to get articles

Here are some alternatives to access the publications essential for your research, when EPFL doesn't have a current subscription.

Request the publisher's version of the article

via EPFL Library

- **Inter Library Loan (ILL):** fast and cheap option (cost supported by the Library).
- **Pay per view (PPV):** faster but expensive option, only if your request is urgent (cost supported by the Library).

Fill the ILL form in the [BEAST catalog](#) (please indicate urgency level in the comments)
Detailed information on go.epfl.ch/peb

via the author

- Traditionally a well-used route.
Contact directly the author of the paper

Get immediate access when available to a version of the article (pre/post-print, publisher's version)

Unpay-wall

- Check availability of research articles as you browse, using Unpaywall index of legal Open Access articles. Install the free browser extension for Chrome and Firefox.

Open Access button

- Free, legal research articles delivered instantly or automatically requested from authors. You can do this from the website, or install a browser extension/API.

Google Scholar button

- Find full text on the web. Select the title of the paper on the page you're reading, and click the Scholar button to find it. Free browser extension for Chrome and Firefox.
