



\*The dose rate H\*(10) measured at 10 cm from the surface doesn't exceed 0.1 µSv/h after subtracting the background.

- If the grids are contaminated only with BSL1 organisms, you can throw them in the same container of the other uranium salt solution contaminated wastes.
- When throwing grids with BSL2 contamination together with non-autoclavable BSL2 wastes, you must keep track of the total number of grids thrown in the period between two consecutive waste checks performed by the SRPO.
