

Main hazards



- Injuries due to flying particles during grinding
- Hand injuries
- Bursting of the grinding wheel
- Falling parts
- Caught in pins or wire brushes
- Dust inhalation
- Burns due to contact with hot surfaces of parts



Safety rules

- Use only safe grinding machines and follow the instructions in the operating manual.
- Use only by trained personnel.
- Wear safety goggles.
- Wear safety shoes.
- Wear protective gloves if necessary when handling sharp-edged parts.
- Wear hearing protection if necessary.
- Wear respiratory protection if necessary.
- Carry out a resonance test before tightening the grinding wheel.
- Adjust the supports and protective caps correctly.
- Do not grind chains, cables, or parts with numerous holes or spikes when working with a wire brush (risk of being caught in the brush).
