

How to scribe

1. Take notes during class.
2. Download the scribe style file from the course home page.
3. Transcribe your notes using Latex, as described in the style file.
4. Email the tutor your `.tex`, `.bib` file (if you used one), and `.pdf` file at the latest 4 days after the lecture (i.e. until Sunday evening).

It is *not sufficient* to only transcribe what was written on the board. In between writings on the board, the lecturer verbally gives explanations, intuition, and other helpful remarks. You must *also* transcribe a selection of these. The goal is to produce a document that someone, who did not attend the class could read and learn from.

The submitted notes will be graded. Recall that scribing one lecture qualifies for 5 bonus points.
