Please read this document carefully. It is required to be properly filled, signed and sent to the person mentioned at the bottom of the page in order to be able to access Cadence tools and to use the Cadence licenses obtained through the Europractice project.

By filling and signing this document, I agree that:

- The Cadence software tools and associated documentation (hereafter *Cadence tools*) licensed to EPFL through the Europractice project are used only in accordance with the terms of the Europractice-Cadence End User license agreement (EUA) already signed by EPFL (a copy of a blank EUA is attached to this document).
- The Cadence tools are kept confidential and only accessed by bona-fide EPFL staff and students for their legitimate studies, duties, and research.
- The Cadence tools may not be used for any commercial purposes, including contract design and re-assignment of IP to any third party. Industrial partners (e.g., in CTI projects) are informed of such requirements.
- All data produced with the Cadence tools (e.g., schematics, layouts, simulation or synthesis results) shall remain in the EPFL network, unless a specific arrangement has been defined with Cadence. For the avoidance of doubt, none of the IP created using Europractice licenses may be licensed, sold, assigned or otherwise transferred to any third party, but shall remain vested at all times in EPFL.
