


# Ponding and Migration for chloride ingress study

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# The techniques explained Ponding


- Close to natural conditions
- [Cl<sup>-</sup>]=0.5M
- Neutral pH
- Thick samples
- Measure of chloride concentrations as a function of depth
- 6 months to a few years
  - → can be compared to real structure cores






#### Migration

- Accelerated conditions: applied voltage to accelerate diffusion
- [Cl<sup>-</sup>]=0.5M
- High pH
- Thin samples (3cm)
- Measure of current, analysis with numerical model
- ~ 2 weeks
  - → faster to carry out in labs





## What can we get from the techniques



Chloride ingress is one of the main degradation process of reinforcement concrete.

Source of chlorides include seawater or de-icing salts.

These techniques can be used to


- predict the service life of infrastructure and buildings
- classify the resistance of different formulations
- understand the mechanisms behind chloride ingress


Ponding provides a result close to real structure while migration is faster to run, and it can be analysed with numerical models to provide microstructure information.



## Applications

#### Classification of Supplementary Cementitious Materials





Same trends between the two techniques, SCMs improves chloride resistance.

LC3 formulation (OPC, clay and limestone) shows the best resistance.

Coupling with microstructure techniques (XRD, MIP, SEM-EDX, ...) provides a better understanding of the underlying mechanisms.
