Introduction by Vice-President for Europe – Prof. Lyesse Laloui: ISSMGE Europe -a very dynamic community with very high standard activities, representing in terms of members almost half of the entire ISSMGE Community.

Regarding our Profession

- Bring together in the society the entire from academia-design-execution, control, etc.
- Bring practitioners closer to the Society.
- In UK there is in initiative to attract professionals to the society. A number of 3 seminars are planned. The seminars are dedicated to sharing practical knowledge.
- An idea discussed was to advertise these seminars to all National Societies.
- In addition, the idea of launching a series of seminars at European level with the purpose of sharing knowledge and expertise and implicate and attract practitioners.
- Possible topics: Artificial Intelligence, Big Data, Climate Change, Energy, etc.
- Establish a list of 6 events that will take place online, monthly.
- National Societies to propose topics and also Speakers for these events.
- During these events non-technical topics may also be addressed such as: The future of our profession, how to attract more people in the field of geotechnical engineering, etc. In the case of non-technical events, they will be organized such as round tables.
- Proposals are expected also for young members of the community to engage in the organization of these events.
