Travel information from the Lausanne main train station to the EPFL

Go out of the train station and cross the "Place de la Gare", either via the main hall or via the subway passage.

The <u>subway</u> station entrance is just on the right side of the Mc Donald's, before the Hotel Intercontinental. Bug a ticket for zones 11+12.

Take the <u>subway M2 direction "Croisettes"</u> and go out at the stop **Lausanne-FLON** (= 1 stop).

At this stop, you will have to take the subway called the <u>TSOL</u> (=**metro M1**). It is a level above the M2 line. Take the <u>TSOL</u> direction "Renens CFF" and go out at the stop **UNIL-Sorge** (= 8 stops).

Additional information

There is a TSOL departure every 10 minutes.

The price of the ticket is CHF 2.80 valid for one hour and for both subways (M2 & TSOL).

The trip, from the Lausanne train station to the UNIL-Sorge stop, lasts about 20 to 25 minutes. You can add about 5 to 10 minutes walking to get to your EPFL final destination. Please, find here a picture of our building, called "le Batochime".

To go from the city center of Lausanne to EPFL by public transportation, you should buy a one hour ticket for 2 zones (11 and 12). This costs 2.80 Swiss francs. The machines accept Swiss coins and Euro coins, but they do not take bank notes. However, If you plane to do more than two trips in a day, you better buy a one day ticket, which costs 8.00 Swiss francs (this is called "carte journalière").
