



5. PROGRAMA DE INTERVENÇÃO

O Projeto destina-se à edificação de um lote municipal (Lote 4) para habitação coletiva, com uma área de comércio no piso térreo, e estacionamento em cave. Deve ter em consideração os seguintes parâmetros:

Na solução a elaborar devem ser cumpridos os valores máximos de área por fogo definidos nas normas para Habitação de Custos Controlados - HCC (Portaria n.º 65/2019, com a redação dada pela Portaria n.º 281/2021), podendo estes parâmetros ser majorados até 20%, de acordo com o previsto no ponto 2.25 do Código do IVA.

O edifício a construir não pode ultrapassar a altura máxima de fachada definida no Loteamento, bem como, o n.º máximo de pisos, acima e abaixo do solo.

No piso térreo devem ser reservadas áreas para os seguintes usos: áreas técnicas, áreas comuns e comunitárias, e área de comércio (projeto social).

Na cobertura do edifício podem ser propostas soluções que incentivem a valorização paisagística e a integração das construções na envolvente verde próxima (Monsanto). Admite-se o aproveitamento do desnível da cobertura, com possível integração de terraços, áreas verdes / ajardinadas que poderão ser para utilização comum dos moradores.

No desenho de implantação do edifício a construir deve ser mantido o alinhamento com o plano marginal do edificado. A profundidade do novo edifício não pode ultrapassar o limite do polígono de implantação definido no Loteamento Municipal. A partir do piso térreo a profundidade de empena do edifício deverá ser de 14,50 m, conforme indicado na Planta Síntese do Loteamento.
