

IIC PRIZE
Regulations

1. The prize is intended to reward up to two students of the Civil Engineering Section for the excellent academic quality of their Master's project, which should preferably be of research nature.
2. To be eligible, the student must have obtained a grade equal to or greater than 5.5, and the project must have been supervised by either one laboratory or preferably by two separate laboratories affiliated to the Civil Engineering Institute.
3. This prize is renewed every year by decision of the Institute.
4. The prize money is taken from the budget of the Institute.
5. The prize awards 1'000.- CHF (one thousand Swiss francs) to each student.
6. The jury is composed of the Director of the Civil Engineering Institute, the Director of the Civil Engineering Section, and a professor chosen by them amongst the Institute's Faculty, excluding those who have supervised the Master's project.
7. This prize is awarded during the Civil Engineering Master's graduation ceremony.
