## General indications:

- Submit your file in English, **electronically**, in **one** document (pdf) to secretariat.sb@epfl.ch
- Be well structured and concise
- Emphasize strong points (publications with strong impact, impact on the scientific community or on education, etc.)
- Start a new page with every Chapter
